

Clear Lake Classical 5th and 6th Grade School Supply List - 2021-2022

For Daily Work (These do not have to be new if previous year's supplies are in good condition.)

- Water bottle
- Several packages of favorite chewing gum for math
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 individual size hand sanitizer bottle - can be refilled at school
- 1 hand sanitizer pump (60% alcohol or more) - **BOYS only**
- 1 Container of Sanitizing wipes (Hydrogen Peroxide or Seventh Generation) and a container of spray cleanser - **GIRLS only**
- 12 Pencils - mechanical or Ticonderoga #2
- 4-6 Pens: blue or black (Please make certain the pens you buy fit your student's hand and flow easily in order for them to have their best handwriting. Rolling ball pens, such as Papermate and Ink Joy have a slightly larger barrel and are best for this purpose rather than cheaper Bic pens, for example.
- Pencil top erasers
- Sharpie BRAND 32174PP Twin Tip Black Permanent Marker (Fine and Ultra Fine) --
- Sharpie Fine Point Permanent Markers (Set of 8 Assorted Colors) -----
- Set of colored fine tip ink pens (Pilot, Mr. Pen, etc. or similar brand:4-10 count)
- Whiteout (bottle, correction tape, or pen type)
- 4 white board markers ultra fine (black or colored assortment)
- Scissors
- Post it notes - for bookmarks and notes
- (1) 4" white three ring binder
- (1) 1 1/2" white three ring binder 4 plastic pocket folders with prongs - one each: red, yellow, blue, and green (6th graders have their folders from last year)
- Mead wide-ruled notebook paper - 200 sheets
- Plastic page protectors - 50 count or more
- Dividers for 3-ring binder - 20 count
- 12" ruler - clear with both inches and centimeters
- Protractor
- Compass
- Basic calculator - with a square root calculation button
- Pencil Case or School caddy



For PE

- Good athletic shoes
- CLC shirt purchased from the school office (\$10)
- Athletic shorts and/or pants: navy, gray, or black (Shorts must be knee length.)

SPECIAL NOTE For All Students Regarding Typing:

Students will be asked to hand write composition papers for the 1st Quarter. Beginning 2nd Quarter, the students will be allowed and encouraged to type their composition papers. Beginning 3rd Quarter, all students will be expected to type their composition papers.

We recommend that all 5th and 6th grade students have computer accessibility at home. We are asking that all students complete a typing tutor program such as Mavis Beacon. (There is a free Mavis Beacon typing tutor available for PC's at [Mavis Beacon Free](http://www.mavisbeaconfree.com/). (<http://www.mavisbeaconfree.com/>) If this tutor program doesn't work for you, find one that will work with your computer.

It is suggested that all 5th & 6th grade students spend time (2 or three times a week) over the summer with a typing tutor, maybe even complete a typing tutor program! There **will not** be computers available at school for composition writing.
